Dear Bethel Daughters,

We are happy to announce that the Grand Guardian Council will once again be awarding scholarships to the outstanding Job's Daughters of Missouri, at Grand Session. To be eligible for a scholarship or loan, you need to have been an active Job's Daughter for one year or a Majority Member, not over 25 years of age. Past recipients of scholarships are able to apply again and will be considered after the first time applicants. Scholarships will vary in amounts.

Daughters will be chosen to receive a scholarship based on the following:

- Daughter's contribution to her Bethel and Community
- Scholastic standing in high school or college
- Recommendations from the Executive Bethel Guardian Council
- Responses to the questions on the application

**Loans:** Daughters that are eligible for a scholarship may also apply for a loan to continue their education. Scholarship winners are also eligible to apply for loans. Loans cannot exceed \$300.00. For more information about loans, please contact the scholarship committee.

**Please follow the instruction checklist and the deadline of March 31, 2018.** The committee would like to award as many scholarships as possible. If your application is not complete, you will not be eligible to receive a scholarship.
