If a Daughter or Jobie-to-Bee is planning to enter any project into the Arts & Crafts Competition, but is not sure if the project will be completed, please have her register anyway. It is better to register an item that you are unable to complete than to bring an unregistered item we cannot accept. This will allow us to have enough space to display all the entries. You do not need to attend Grand Session to enter. If you are not attending, you may still register items and send them with your Bethel or Bethel representative.

Entries are limited to one per category. Bethel Guardians, please help choose the appropriate category for your Daughters & Jobie-to-Bees work. If you have any questions about categories, please feel free to contact us.

Entries must be turned in to the Arts & Crafts room on Wednesday, June 19th from 6-9 pm or Thursday, June 20th from 8:30-11:30 am. Only items that have been registered will be accepted. The room will close at 11:30 am for judging to begin.

For each entry, the Daughter or Jobie-to-Bee's name and Bethel number are to be written on and index card and placed inside an envelope. The envelope should have the category and age written on the outside. This envelope must be attached to the entered item. All items must have their own envelope.

Digital Art - Illustrations created using a computer.

Pillows - May be any shape or size, hand or machine sewn.

Sewing - Items sewn by hand or machine including clothing, quilts, stuffed animals, etc. No Pillows are allowed to be entered into this category.

Yarn Crafts - Items made with yarn including knitting, crochet, macrame, etc

Jewelry - Any type of jewelry you have made including necklaces, earrings, rings, bracelets, brooches/pins, etc.

Home Decor - Made items used to decorate a home including floral designs, wall hangings, vases, candle holders, picture frames, cross stitch, etc.

Photography - Any unaltered photograph taken by you in black and white or color.

Photo Art - Any photograph taken by you which has been manipulated in some way including digitally, overpainting, etc.

Scrapbooks - Any recent Bethel or non-Bethel scrapbook. It must be solely the work of the Daughter or Jobie-to-Bee entering it.

Recycling - Pieces constructed from recycled/found items that would have otherwise ended up in the trash or recycling bin.

Baking - Items must be non perishable and will be tasted as part of the judging process. This is the only category that will allow a food item.

Miscellaneous - This category is for any pieces that do not fit into any other category.

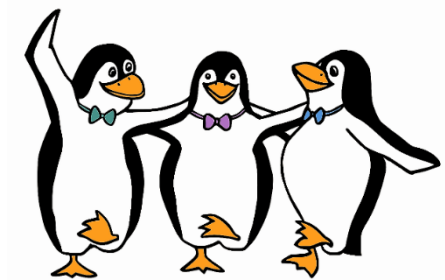

The Performing Arts competition will once again feature: Vocal solos and ensembles, Instrumental solos and ensembles, Sign Language solos and ensembles, along with Team Choir and Sign Language. With the great response from last year, we will be having Drill Team competition again. The competitions are opened to all active Job's Daughters and Jobies-to-Bees.

We hope that this year, as in the past, our many talented girls will participate in these competitions and impress the judges with the high quality of their performances. The following pages include all the guidelines and information for the competitions. **PLEASE READ THEM CAREFULLY** and email me any questions you might have. Also enclosed are the competition forms for all entrants. Please make as many copies as are needed so all the girls have an opportunity to compete. The completed forms can be sent via regular mail or scanned and emailed to me.

Choose your competitions soon, and begin to practice. We look forward to hearing and seeing all of you at Grand Session.

Guidelines:

1. Competition will begin at 9:00 am on Thursday, June 20, 2019 and will be held one (1) day only. Score sheets will be at the competition room. There will be assigned times for the team competitions. If you chose not to participate in a competition you have signed up for, PLEASE let me know ASAP so the judges aren't waiting on you to show. This saves the judges' time and we don't have to come search for you during competitions.
2. Jobies-2-Bees will be able to compete in all Performing Arts Competitions at the 2019 Session. Jobies-2-Bees are those who have received the ceremony and are nine (9) years of age or younger.
3. All entrants must be active members in good standing/have received the Jobie-2-Bee ceremony.
4. Registration forms **MUST** be mailed or emailed to the Grand Director of Music postmarked/date-stamped no later than May 15, 2019.
5. Please type or print all information. No Late entries will be accepted.
6. All performances other than team divisions will have a minimum time limit of one (1) minute and a maximum time limit of six (6) minutes.
7. See team divisions for time limit information.
8. Bethel choir participants and team sign language participants must be from the same Bethel.
9. Ensemble groups may be from different Bethels. Please indicate those from other bethels on forms.
10. Each entry must be submitted on a separate entry form
11. CD's, MP3s, Ipods, etc. used for accompaniment must NOT have accompanying vocals except for sign language, Drill, and dance competition. Points will be deducted if background vocals are used. A CD player will be in the vocal, sign language, and dance competition rooms for participants' use.
12. Please indicate on each entry if you will be using a CD, Ipod, or none, to make sure we have the correct equipment in the room
13. Vocal solo and ensemble participants will be required to sing "Forward All Job's Daughters" from memory. This is found in the music packet (enclosed). A CD of the music will be provided in the competition room.

14. Bethel Choirs will be required to sing specified versus in "Come Alive" from The Greatest Showman. See the lyrics attached for which verses. Ritual CD's will be given to those Bethels that do not have one if requested from the Grand Director of Music. A CD with this required song will be in the competition room and the judges will have the sheet music.
15. At least one (1) copy of the music or scripts to be viewed by the judges must be presented at the time of competition (sheet music, published book, original work) other than for required songs as discussed in #13 and #14 above. Sheet music is not required for the dance competition. Copyright laws only permit copied music if the original is out of print. An original piece, written by the Daughter, is acceptable and encouraged. A page with just the words listed or no sheet music provided at all will result in loss of points. The decision of the committee on all music to be used is final. Sheet music should have measures numbered from beginning to end.
16. For sign language, (1) one copy of printed lyrics are required for the Judges.
17. We will again hold the Jobies Talent Showcase following the Formal Opening Thursday evening. The judges will decide on which acts should be chosen for this. This isn't necessarily the first place winners.
18. Music, scripts, and score sheets will be returned to participants by Sunday morning.

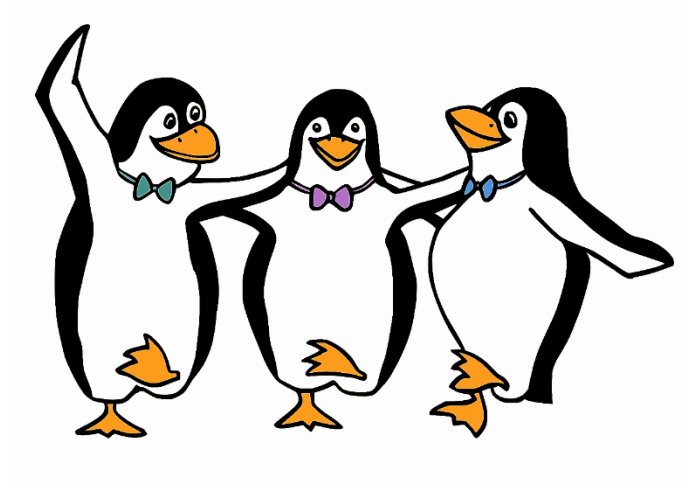
