

Contingency Plan for 2020 Grand Session Grand Bethel of Missouri

Due to the announcement from the Board of Trustees, Executive Officers and the Jurisprudence Committee of the Supreme Guardian Council suspending all in-person activities until August 31, 2020, the following Contingency Plan shall be used:

Grand Bethel of Missouri

Elected & Selected Grand Bethel Officers and Representatives

- Grand Bethel Senior Princess Olivia Van Tine will advance to the office of Grand Bethel Honored Queen and Grand Bethel Junior Princess Megan Kemery will advance to the office of Grand Bethel Senior Princess effective Friday, June 26, 2020.
- The office of Grand Bethel Junior Princess shall remain vacant at this time.
- The 2019-2020 Grand Bethel Officers and Representatives will retain their office until the 2020-2021 Officers and Representatives are installed.
- The 2020-2021 Grand Bethel Officers and Grand Bethel Representatives will be selected virtually on Friday, June 26, 2020.
- To be selected as a Grand Bethel Officer or Representative:
 1. 2019-2020 Grand Bethel Representatives must turn in a completed report by June 11th, 2020 to be eligible for the drawing this year. Reports can be turned into Jenna Walden (STL) [dinolover2021@gmail.com] or Katrina Butler (KC) [katrinathekiwi@gmail.com].
 2. No Grand Bethel Officer or Representative shall be selected for an office and/or as a Representative more than two (2) consecutive terms provided there is another eligible Grand Bethel member from the same Bethel who has not served two (2) terms.
 3. Each Daughter who desires to be placed in the selection shall pay the Grand Bethel the amount of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for Grand Bethel dues PRIOR to the selection AND provide the Grand Bethel with her completed and signed Grand Bethel Registration card.
 4. Completed forms and dues should be mailed to:

 5. Received forms shall be checked for completeness by the Grand Bethel Council and Advisory Board. Should any questions arise as to the content, the Grand Bethel Advisory Board will contact the young ladies before June 26th.
 6. Members of this Grand Bethel who are Dual Members will only be entered in the drawing once. The Bethel number indicated on their Grand Bethel Registration card will be the only Bethel they shall be entered under for the entirety of the drawing.
 7. Selection of Grand Bethel Officers and Representatives shall begin with the Grand Bethel Musician.
 8. Honored Queens, Honored Queens-Elect/Select, Past Honored Queens and Majority Members present shall be given first consideration for selective offices. Unfilled selective offices may then be available to the remaining members of this Grand Bethel.
 9. Not more than one (1) member from the same Bethel, as declared on Grand Bethel dues registration, shall hold a selective office until all Bethels with eligible members present are represented.

10. Not more than one (1) member from the same Bethel, as declared on Grand Bethel dues registration, shall be selected as a Grand Bethel Representative until all Bethels present are represented. Bethels not having a Grand Bethel Officer shall have first selection.
 11. No member shall hold two (2) offices or positions as a Grand Bethel Representative at one time. Neither shall she hold office and serve as a Grand Bethel Representative at the same time.
 12. The drawing shall be under the direction of the Vice Associate Grand Bethel Guardian.
 13. In the event that a selected Grand Bethel Officer and/or Representative is elected as Grand Bethel Junior Princess once the suspension is lifted, the next eligible Daughter from her Bethel shall be given the first right of refusal to fill the vacancy. In the event that there isn't another eligible Daughter, the Grand Bethel Council will need to identify which Bethels have eligible Daughters and/or identify which Bethel would have been next in the drawing.
- An announcement of the new Grand Bethel Officers and Representatives will be sent via email to all Bethels and posted on the Missouri Job's Daughters website.
 - Completed Grand Bethel Registration forms for those selected in the drawing shall be retained for the purpose of the Grand Bethel Directory.

Meetings

- Any business to be brought before the Grand Bethel of Missouri at the Annual Session shall be postponed until such time that a Special Meeting has been called by the Grand Bethel Honored Queen and Grand Bethel Council.
- This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Election of 2020-2021 Grand Bethel Junior Princess
 - Reports of 2019-2020 Grand Bethel Committees

Installation

- A virtual Installation will be held to install the Grand Bethel Honored Queen and Grand Bethel Senior Princess.
 - The Queen Bee shall be drawn during the virtual Installation.
 - Only those Jobie-to-Bees who have submitted a completed and signed form shall be eligible for the drawing.
- The Official Installation of 2020-2021 Grand Bethel Officers & Representatives shall be postponed until such time as it is deemed safe to resume in-person activities of MOJDI.
 - Installation location shall be at the discretion of the Grand Bethel Honored Queen and the Grand Bethel Council.
