5. Entries must be postmarked on or by **July 3, 2020**. Electronic entries must be sent no later than **July 3, 2020**.

## **Category: Jobie to Bee**

**Entrant:** Any Jobie-to-Bee member, ages 7-9

**Theme:** Write a note to Mother Mick thanking her for starting Job's Daughters. You may include what you enjoy about being a Bee, what you have learned about Job's Daughters or what you are looking forward to most as a member of Job's Daughters.



- Requirements:**
- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 2) Double Space
  - 3) Length should be no more than one (1) page typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should NOT appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2019-20 Supreme Guardian Year

## **Category: New Member Essay**

**Entrant:** Any Daughter who has been initiated since Supreme Session 2019. Age categories will be determined based on the number of entries.

**Theme:** Write a letter to Mother Mick telling her about your initiation ceremony. You may include what had the most impact on you, which messenger part you liked the most, or how you can use what you learned in your everyday life.

- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel
  - 2) Double Space
  - 3) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should NOT appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2019-20 Supreme Guardian Year

## **Category: Essay**

**Entrant:** Age 10-12, age 13-15, and age 16-20

**Theme:** 'Dear Mother Mick' – Write a letter to Mother Mick telling her about your experience in Job's Daughters. You may include how Job's Daughters has influenced your life or about the skills you are learning that you will use throughout your life.

- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 2) Double space
  - 3) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should NOT appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2019-20 Supreme Guardian Year

## Category: Poetry

**Entrant:** Age 10-12, age 13-15, and age 16-20

**Theme:** Write an epic poem telling of the journey of Mother Mick as she follows her dream to create Job's Daughters.

- Requirements:**
- 1) Use size 12 Times New Roman or Ariel font
  - 2) Double space
  - 3) Length should be no more than three (3) pages typed
  - 4) Your Name, Bethel, or Location should NOT appear on the piece
  - 5) Piece must have been written during the 2019-20 Supreme Year

## Category: Creative Writing

**Entrant:** Age 10-12, age 13-15, and age 16-20

**Theme:** Use your time traveling skills to write a short story about Job's Daughters back in 1920, today in 2020 and into the future OR tell us how one of the following mottos relates to your journey in Job's Daughters:

SBHQ Motto: 'In a World where you can be anything, be kind.'  
MIJD Motto 'Here's to who we are and who we can become.'  
SG & ASG Motto: 'JDI Celebrating 100 years with 2020 Vision.'
