Dear Bethel Daughters,

The Scholarship Committee of the Grand Guardian Council of Missouri is accepting applications for the 2024 Scholarships to be awarded at Grand Session in June. Daughters of Missouri Bethels who have been active members for not less than one (1) year or Majority Members who are not over twenty-five (25) years of age are eligible to apply. Former applicants and recipients may apply, and receive up to four scholarships with a possible maximum value of \$4,000.00. The amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) shall be allowed for each scholarship while working toward your primary degree or professional certificate. Please note that scholarships can be awarded to Daughters that are attending a trade school also. We encourage all who are eligible to apply.

Please refer to SOP-GGC-3 Educational and Promotional Funds, MO-Section 2. Educational Fund (e) Scholarships for complete details.

Scholarship winners will be ranked and chosen based on the following criteria:

- Scholastic standing in high school or college
- Contribution to Bethel and Community
- Letter of Recommendation from the Bethel Guardian Council signed by three members of the Executive Bethel Guardian Council
- Response and completeness to the Scholarship Questionnaire

Please follow the instructions and checklist and observe the postmark deadline of April 20, 2024. If everything is not included, you will not be eligible to receive a scholarship. The committee is excited to award as many scholarships as possible.

Daughters may also apply for a loan to continue their education. Loans cannot exceed \$300.00. If you have an interest in a loan, please contact the Scholarship Committee.

2. Fill out the Scholarship Application completely. Make sure that both you and your parent or legal guardian sign and date the form.
3. Answer all questions on the scholarship questionnaire on a separate sheet of paper. It would be best for you to type or use black or blue ink in your best handwriting.
4. Send the application, questionnaire, personal statement, and letter of recommendation by email or mail postmarked no later than April 20, 2024. To the address listed below.
