Supreme Session Dress Code It is the responsibility of everyone attending Supreme Session to dress appropriately. Please remember that your attire and behavior reflect Job's Daughters and we want to ensure that it is a positive reflection. *Short-shorts, cutoffs, crop tops, halter tops, or bare midriffs are not allowed.*

Formal Events (Formal Opening, Formal Banquet, MIJD Coronation and Supreme Bethel & Supreme Guardian Council Installations.)

- Ladies: knee length or longer formals, gowns or dressy dresses or dressy palazzo style pants. Appropriately fitted strapless, halter, one shoulder, spaghetti straps are acceptable, however, at no time should any undergarments be shown.
- Men: Tuxedo, suits or sport coat and tie.

Supreme Bethel

- Daughters: Must be in robes with white or purple cords. Only the SBHQ, SBSP, SBJP and MIJD will be in cape and crown.
- Ladies: knee length or longer skirts or dresses, or dress pants. All tops should be in good taste, no plunging necklines.
- Men: dress pants or slacks with collared shirt, polo or sport coat & tie.

Meetings (Supreme Guardian Council Meetings & Registered Meals)

- Ladies: knee length or longer skirts or dresses, or dress pants. All tops should be in good taste, no plunging necklines.
