FULL REGISTRATION PACKAGE INCLUDES 4 HOTEL NIGHTS AND 10 MEALS: All those attending the entire session MUST purchase the FULL PACKAGE. This package includes the following: Registration Fee, Hotel Accommodations from Wednesday, June 25th through Sunday morning, June 29th and 10 meals. Meals included are Thursday breakfast, lunch and Formal Banquet, Friday breakfast, lunch and dinner, Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner and Sunday Farewell Breakfast. *JDI Youth is defined as an Active Job’s Daughter, a dues-paying majority member of the Grand Bethel between the age 20-25 with CAV and a Jobie-to-Bee who has received the J2B Ceremony. The reduced price for our JDI Youth is due to the generous donation from the Grand Lodge of Missouri.

LATE FEES: There will be a **\$50 late fee** for Individual or Bethel registrations **received AFTER May 14, 2025**.

SHORT STAY ATTENDEES: If you are not purchasing the Full Package, there will be a \$35.00 Session Registration Fee plus the cost of any individual meals you choose to purchase as well as hotel accommodations at \$100 per room for each night you specify. Please complete the Short Stay Attendees Form.

CHECK-IN: Upon arrival at the Capitol Plaza Hotel, please check in at the Job's Daughters Grand Session Registration table to pick up your packet and room keys. Room Key Bracelets will be issued ONLY to the Bethel Guardian (or her designated representative). Please do not go to the hotel front desk and request keys. PLEASE NOTE: Rooms will be available after 4 pm.

NAME TAGS: For the safety of all attendees your name tag MUST be worn at ALL times. During competitions, please have a designated adult to hold these while Members/Jobies-to-Bee are competing.

REGISTRATION & CREDENTIALS:

Voting Delegates: Defined as current Executive Bethel Guardian Council members, Past Bethel Guardians, Past Associate Bethel Guardians, Grand Officers, Past Grand Guardians, and Past Associate Grand Guardians. To our PBG, PABG, PGG and PAGG, if you are a current associate council position, you must register as a voting delegate. Voting fee is \$15 per person and is not included in the package deal.

Non-Voting Delegates: Defined as Associate Members of a Bethel Guardian Council (that are not PBG, PABG, PGG and/or PAGG), other adults, visitors, Jobies-to-Bee and other children. Non-Voting fee is \$3 per person and is not included in the package deal.

All Voting and Non-Voting Delegates will need to sign in at the Credentials table. NO CREDENTIALS WILL BE MAILED TO VOTING DELEGATES. Credential table availability will be noted in the Grand Session program booklet.

JOBIE CONGRESS: The Grand Bethel Trio and Vice Supreme Guardian will meet with the Daughters Wednesday evening to discuss amendments and the additional Ritual Revisions to be voted on at Supreme Session. Voting Delegates of the SGC are also invited to attend so that they hear the wishes of our Daughters on the upcoming additional Ritual changes. GRAND LIBRARIAN & GRAND DIRECTOR OF MUSIC COMPETITIONS: A complete packet of information is enclosed with details for the competitions. Chris Davis, Grand Librarian, and Melissa Winebaugh, Grand Director of Music, will oversee competitions. Please refer all questions to their attention. All competitions will be held on Thursday, June 26th from 8am to 1:30pm. If you receive a scheduled time, please be prompt.

FLAG CEREMONY: During the Formal Opening there will be a Flag Ceremony under the direction of Mom Tanja Orwig, Grand Marshal. It is requested that your Bethel bring your American, Bethel, and Jobie-to-Bee Flags to Grand Session for this ceremony. We strongly encourage the Daughters to compete in several of the Grand Librarian competitions from Arts & Crafts to Creative Communications and especially Ritual. In addition, we hope that you will encourage your Jobie-to-Bees to participate in the Arts and Crafts, Creative Communications & Ritual competitions. While we look forward to having them at Grand Session and taking part in the Jobie-to-Bee activities, they do not need to be present to win for the Arts & Crafts & Creative Communication Competition.

The Ritual category will offer a Ritual Test for all Daughters. This is a 30-minute, multiple choice or fill in the blank, closed-book test similar to the correspondence course. Medallions for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded. This is a great way to show off your knowledge of our Order and we encourage all members, old and new, to take this test. Answer sheets will be returned so that you can use them as a study tool.

There will be **NO LIMIT** to how many Ritual competitions each Daughter may enter. However the following point ranges will be necessary to place regardless of how many Daughters compete in a particular category:

1000 points possible
900 - 1000 - 1st place
750 - 899 - 2nd place
650 - 749 - 3rd place

The Majority Division is for those who have reached the age of 20 and are Majority members of the Order.

As in the past, upon arrival at the Capitol Plaza, the designated adult from your Bethel may pick up the Bethel Competition Packet when picking up the Grand Session Registration packet.

Bethel Guardians, please keep in mind that in the past some of our Daughters may not have been able to compete because of missed deadlines. Again, this year deadlines will be strictly enforced. A listing of competition rooms will be posted at the hotel and a list of the Daughters registered for competition will be posted outside the competition rooms. Judging is on a "first come, first serve" basis. If a girl has changed her mind and does not want to compete, there will be a basket located in front of the Grand Librarian's room for blank score sheets to denote the Daughter will no longer be competing with no questions asked. The room will be clearly marked.

There will be NO LIMIT to how many Ritual competitions each J2B, Daughter or Majority Member may enter.

1. Robes: All contestants, except for the Jobie-2-Bee and Majority Divisions, will be judged in official regalia. Cords may be either purple or white and must be stitched to the yoke in the appropriate manner. We will not be judging the quality of the robe or the type of fabric it is made from. We will be checking for all appropriate parts of the regalia and to see that accessories are appropriate. The overall general appearance of the member in the robe is what will be judged upon entering the ritual competition room. For all ritual competitions, scoring will begin when the judge indicates that "You may begin."
2. Majority Division: A majority member may compete in multiple individual Messenger lectures, Story of Job & as part of a Majority Member Ritual Team. Please wear nice dress clothing when competing.
3. Story of Job: You will present the work of all five messengers as a single story **without** instructions to the Guide and Marshal.
4. Honored Queen – Membership Ceremony: The Daughter shall present all Honored Queen parts beginning with "Membership Ceremony" on page 41 of the ritual and concluding with the instructions to the Inner Guard on page 54 of the ritual. The part includes all indicated elements of the new Proficiency Work.
5. Senior Princess – Membership Ceremony: The Daughter shall present all Senior Princess parts for the Membership Ceremony beginning with her initial address to the new members on page 48 and continuing through her examination of the Junior Princess on page 52. The part includes all indicated elements of the new Proficiency Work.
6. Junior Princess – Membership Ceremony: The Daughter shall present all of the Junior Princess' part for the Membership Ceremony beginning with her instructions to the Guide and Marshal on page 44 and concluding with her examination by the Senior Princess on page 52. The part includes all indicated elements of the Proficiency Work.
7. Guide – Membership Ceremony: The Daughter shall present the Guide's presentation and questioning of the candidates as shown on page 42. The Daughter shall indicate her floor work for this section to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
8. Chaplain: The Daughter shall present all of the Chaplain's solo parts in the following order. Pledge of Honor for Adults, on page 19; Obligation on page 43, including Proficiency Work No. 2; Prayer at the conclusion of the Membership Ceremony on page 53; the prayer in the Closing Ceremony of a meeting on page 34. The Daughter shall indicate her floor work for attending to and from the altar to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.

9. First Messenger – Membership Ceremony: All active and majority members. You will present the initiation lecture of the First Messenger as presented on page 90 and 91 of the ritual. She will indicate her floor work to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
10. Second Messenger – Membership Ceremony: All active and majority members. You will present the initiation lecture of the Second Messenger as presented on page 91 and 92 of the ritual including the instructions to the Guide and Marshal. She will indicate her floor work to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
11. Third Messenger – Membership Ceremony: All active and majority members. You will present the initiation lecture of the Third Messenger as presented on pages 95 through 97 of the ritual. She will indicate her floor work to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
12. Fourth Messenger – Membership Ceremony: All active and majority members. You will present the initiation lecture of the Fourth Messenger as presented on page 97 and 98 of the ritual including the instructions to the Guide and Marshal. She will indicate her floor work to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
13. Fifth Messenger – Membership Ceremony: All active and majority members. You will present the initiation lecture of the Fifth Messenger as presented on page 101 and 102 of the ritual including the instructions to the Guide and Marshal. She will indicate her floor work to the judge on a drawing of the Bethel Room.
14. Proficiency: The proficiency competition will be divided into two categories - Rookies & All Stars.

The Rookie category will be for Daughters attending their first Grand Session while the All-Star category will be open for all other Daughters competing in the proficiency category. The same Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Divisions will be used across both categories.
15. Team Competition: One team per Bethel is encouraged to compete. Team members may be any active members of the Bethel. The five Messenger lectures are to be given in succession by five different members. Include the instructions for the Guide and Marshal in the work. The winning team will receive the traveling trophy and an individual award will be given to each winning team member. Majority Members are encouraged to create a team & compete in a Majority Division of the Ritual Team Competition. The same rules listed for Bethel teams apply. To place in the top 3 awards, you must receive a minimum score of 600 points.
16. Majority competition will have one overall winner for each Messenger Lecture, Story of Job, and Majority Team.
17. Jobie to Bee: Any Jobie to Bee aged 9 years and under. You will present either the Jobie to Bee Pledge or Friendship Poem. Both can be found below and on the MOJDI.ORG website.

Essay

Each Daughter may enter one essay. The essay topic question for each category is as follows:

Jobie-2-Bee: 9 years and under (Minimum 100 – Maximum 500 words)
“I have magic hair that glows when I sing.” – Rapunzel – If you had magic hair, what good would you do with it?

Junior: 10 – 13 years old (Minimum 200 – Maximum 800 words)
“Heroes are made by the path they choose, not the powers they are graced with.” - Ironman (GG Empowerment Message) What does this saying mean to you?

Intermediate: 14 – 16 years old (Minimum 300 – Maximum 2000 words)
“Live Your Dream.” (GBHQ Motto) How are you living your dream/how do you plan do live your dream?

Senior: 17 – 19 years old (Minimum 400 – Maximum 4000 words)
“Don’t let the past determine your destiny.” (GG/AGG Theme) – What does this mean to you and what advice do you have for the younger members of our order?

Each Daughter and/or Jobie-2-Bee may enter one poem.

Poems must be the original work of the Daughter submitting the entry.

Essays may be printed, legibly handwritten, or typed single sided on standard 8 1/2 X 11 paper.

Poems will be judged based on content, originality, grammar, spelling, punctuation, presentation and effectiveness of the message delivery.

The poem may be freestyle or rhyme. Keep the poem to 16 lines or less.

Competition Information

Each entry must have a registration form completed and submitted with that entry. The original work itself must NOT contain the Daughter’s name, Bethel number, or age. This information should ONLY be on the entry form for each Daughter per each category.

Arts & Crafts Categories

There are fourteen categories this year. The photography category is one of the largest categories; it will be broken into separate categories: Photography and Photo Art. If there are enough entries of the same type of entry in the MISC category a new category for those entries may be made.

Below are the categories and what is included in each:

Sewing	Clothing, quilts, and stuffed animals
Pillows	May be any shape or form. Size must not exceed 2'x2'
Painting	Includes oils, acrylics or watercolors
Drawing	Includes mediums such as pencil, pen, charcoal or pastels
Scrapbooks*	Bethel and non-Bethel items are acceptable. Size must not exceed 16"x20"
Home Décor	Items such as wall hangings, plant containers, candle holders
Jewelry	Usual jewelry items
Photography	Any unaltered color or black and white photography
Photo Art	Photographs that have been digitally altered
Digital Art	Digitally created illustrations
Baking	Items must be non-perishable and will be tasted as part of the judging process. This is the only category that will allow a food item.
Yarn Crafts	Items made with yarn including knitting, crochet, macrame, etc
Computer Generated	Original creation, video photography, promotional videos, photo story
Miscellaneous	Items that do not fit into any of the above categories
Motto:	May be expressed in any medium the Daughters would like to use. Be creative and let those mottos shine!

Individual (Motto): Express the Grand Bethel Honored Queen's motto with your creativity. Any medium will be accepted for this category.

"Live Your Dream"

Bethel (Motto): Any project created by three or more Job's Daughters and/or Jobies to Bee that expresses the Grand Guardian's motto.

and that our greatest power comes from within.

***A Special Note Regarding Scrapbook Entries**

All scrapbooks must be completed for a term in this GGC year. All scrapbooks will be judged on originality, quality, and neatness. Judging for the cover and content of the scrapbook will be on a weighted scale with the cover receiving a smaller percentage of scoring points.

Competition Information

If a Daughter is planning to enter a project but is not certain the project will be completed before the deadline, the girl should register the entry. This allows the committee to plan for the adequate number of display tables. Remember Daughters do not have to attend Grand Session to enter something in the Arts & Crafts Competition. Daughters may only submit one (1) entry per category. Daughters may enter as many categories as they wish, however, please remember we want to see the quality of work of the girls, not the quantity of entries. Guardians, you are encouraged to assist the Daughters in choosing the categories they would like to enter. Each entry must be the sole effort of the Daughter and have been completed within the past GGC year. School projects are appropriate; however, no items made from kits will be accepted.

Entries must be turned into the Art & Crafts room between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on June 26th. Only entries that were **previously registered** will be accepted. (No exceptions.)

Entries will be turned into the volunteer in the Arts and Crafts Room. They will personally place the entry in the proper display. Please do not place entries on the display tables. An adult from the Bethel may submit a Daughter's entries. It is not necessary for the Daughter to turn the entries in herself. Please be patient, when checking in the entries. There may be a line.

The Performing Arts competition will feature: Vocal solos, Bethel Choir and ensembles, Instrumental solos and ensembles, Sign Language solos, team and ensembles, and Drill Competition. There is also a new theater monologue category this year. The competitions are open to all active Job's Daughters, Jobie-to-Bees, and Majority Members. We hope that this year, as in the past, members will participate in these competitions and #SHOWmeMO. The following pages include all the guidelines and information for the competitions. Please read carefully, and contact me with any questions you may have. Also enclosed are the competition forms for all entrants. Make as many copies as needed so all the girls have an opportunity to compete. The completed forms can be sent via regular mail, email, or hand delivered to the address provided.

Guidelines:

1. Competition will take place on Thursday, June 26, 2025. Times for competitions will be announced at a later date. Score sheets and additional instructions will be in a packet to be picked up by the Bethel Guardian at registration.
2. Age Divisions are:
 - Jobie-to-Bee: Age 7-9
 - Junior: Age 10-13
 - Intermediate: Age 14-16
 - Senior: Age 17-19
 - Majority: Age 20+Dance and Instrumental Divisions will be based on experience.
3. Majority Members may enter Vocal Solo, Sign Language Solo or Theatre Solo competition.
4. All Daughters must be active members in good standing. Jobie-to-Bees are those who have received the ceremony. Majority Members must reach the age of 20 in good standing.
5. This year we are using JOT forms. There are different QR codes/links for each competition. Please fill out forms and have them returned to the Grand Director of Music no later than May 14, 2025. No late entries will be accepted.
6. All performances other than team divisions will have a minimum time limit of one (1) minute and a maximum time limit of six (6) minutes. See team divisions for specific time limit information.
7. Bethel choir, Team sign language, and Drill team participants must be from the same Bethel.
8. Ensemble groups may be from different Bethels. Please indicate those other Bethels on the form.
9. Each entry must be submitted on a separate entry form.
10. CD's, digital media, etc. used for accompaniment must NOT have accompanying vocals except for sign language, Drill, and dance competition. Points will be deducted if background vocals are used. A CD player and bluetooth speaker will be in the vocal, sign language, and dance competition rooms for participants' use.
11. Please indicate on each entry if you will be using a CD, BlueTooth Speaker, or none to make sure we have the correct equipment in the room.
12. Vocal solo and ensemble participants will be required to sing from memory "Sweet Hour of Prayer" from the Bethel Music Ritual. Jobie-to-Bees required song is the "Jobie-to-Bee Song". A CD of the music will be provided in the competition room.
13. Bethel Choirs will be required to sing "Nearer my God to Thee" from the Bethel Music Ritual. Ritual CD's will be given to those Bethels that do not have one if requested from the Grand Director of Music. A CD with this required song will be in the competition room and the judges will have the sheet music.

14. For vocal performances: At least one (1) copy of the music or scripts to be viewed by the judges must be presented at the time of competition (sheet music, published book, original work) other than for required songs as discussed in #11 and #12 above. Sheet music is not required for the dance competition. Copyright laws only permit copied music if the original is out of print. An original piece, written by the Daughter, is acceptable and encouraged. A page with just the words listed or no sheet music provided at all will result in loss of points. The decision of the committee on all music to be used is final. Sheet music should have measures numbered from beginning to end.
15. For sign language, (1) one copy of printed lyrics is required for the Judges.
16. We will again hold the Jobie Talent Showcase following the Formal Opening Thursday evening. The judges will decide on which acts will be chosen for this. This isn't necessarily the first place winner.
17. Music, scripts, and score sheets will be returned to participants by Sunday morning.
18. To place in the top 3 awards, you must achieve a minimum score of 70 points.
19. You will receive an email confirmation when your entries are received. If you do not get a confirmation, assume your entry has not been received.

A Sign Language Ensemble consists of 2-4 Daughters/Jobie-to-Bees from any Bethel.

- One copy of printed lyrics is required for the Judges.
- Music must have accompanying vocals
- All performances will have a minimum time limit of one (1) minute and a maximum time limit of six (6) minutes for their chosen song. The timer will begin at the start of the performance.
- Dress should be Job's Daughter meeting attire. A Bethel robe with the proper regalia may also be worn.
- Judging will be based on sign accuracy, precision, synchronization, expression, posture, memorization, and stage presence.

Division 3: Sign Language Team

- All performances will have a minimum time limit of two (2) minutes and a maximum time limit of ten (10) minutes for their chosen song. The timer will begin at the start of the performance.
- Dress should be Job's Daughter meeting attire. A Bethel robe with the proper regalia may also be worn.
- Judging will be based on sign accuracy, precision, synchronization, expression, posture, memorization, and stage presence.

Category E: Drill Team

Division 1: Drill Team

A Drill Team consists of 3 or more Daughters/Jobie-to-Bees from the same Bethel.

- Sheet Music is not required for Drill Team Performances.
- All performances will have a minimum time limit of two (2) minutes and a maximum time limit of ten (10) minutes for their chosen song. The timer will begin at the start of the performance.
- Military or Novelty Drill Performances may be entered.
- Costumes, music, and dance moves should be Job's Daughter appropriate.
- Judging will be based on execution, synchronization, originality, movement, and appearance.

Category F: Theater

Division 1: Individual Monologue

A Monologue is a speech delivered by a single character addressing themselves, another character, or the audience. It may be dramatic or humorous. An original piece written by the Daughter/Jobie-to-Bee is acceptable.

- Selection should be Job's Daughters appropriate.
- At the beginning of the performance, Daughter should state the name of the selection and the author(s). This statement is not included in the time limitation.
- All performances will have a minimum time limit of one (1) minute and a maximum time limit of six (6) minutes for their chosen piece. The timer will begin at the start of the performance.
- Costumes may be worn but should be Job's Daughter appropriate. A Bethel robe with the proper regalia or meeting attire may also be worn.
- Judging will be based upon accuracy, memorization, interpretation, technique, expression, posture, stage presence/use of space, and appropriate attire.


