


IRS 990 FILING

MIJD Lucinda and SBHQ Jacquelyn now have their pins & charms available for sale on their travels! All proceeds go towards the Travel Fund.



JDI PRIDE AWARD




ALL Bethels are invited to participate in the JDI Pride Award!


