During Supreme Session 2025 an immediate amendment was presented to the Supreme Guardian regarding the wearing of religious attire during Job's Daughters meetings. This was read at the Annual Business Meeting by Supreme Jurisprudence and referred to the Board of Trustees (BOT) during that business session.

Your BOT has drafted and approved a policy for religious and cultural accommodations with legal guidance. This has been sent to Supreme Jurisprudence for adoption and publishing into the "Policies of the Board of Trustees Job's Daughters International" section of our Constitution and Bylaws and will be found in section POL-BOT-3 coming up.




