Need new ideas for your Beehive? Want to share some of the awesome things your Hive has done? Share them on our new Padlets!



The JDI Board of Trustees have been working on getting this system created for our Daughters, Parents, CAV Volunteers, Bethels, Jurisdictions and Supreme to use. This system will manage our Membership and Bethel/Jurisdiction needs organization-wide and much, much more at the Bethel, Jurisdictional, Grand, and Supreme levels.

This is the same system that has been adopted by some Grand Lodges and Grand Chapters of the Order of the Eastern Star, as well as their membership in local Lodges and Chapters.

This is a great step in the future of Job's Daughters. More information will be coming out as we get closer to the rollout of Grand View.

ALL Bethels are invited to participate in the JDI Pride Award!


Bethels can earn points for each activity they complete during the term. Ribbons are awarded depending on the number of points earned each term.
