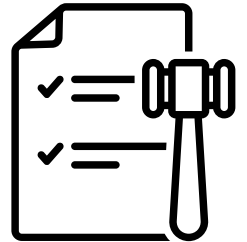

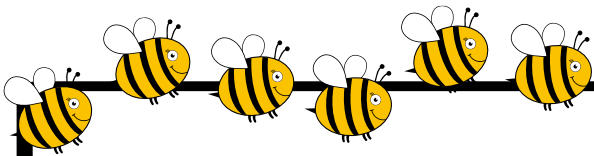
Bethels can earn points for each activity they complete during the term. Ribbons are awarded depending on the number of points earned each term.

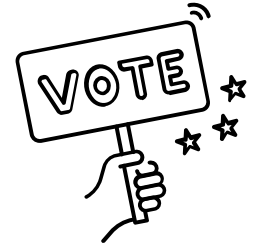


## DAUGHTER VOTING DELEGATES

Visit the library regularly to keep it tidy and stocked, and share photos or updates to help spread awareness of Job's Daughters in your community.



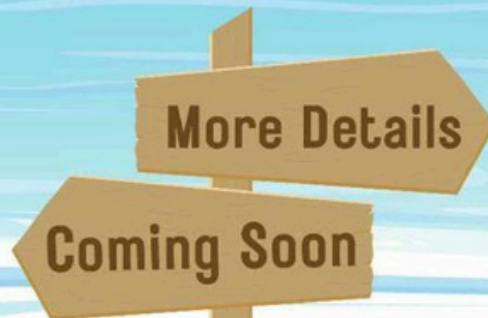

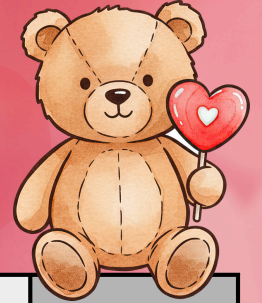
