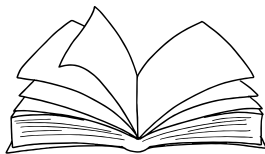

! YOUTH PROTECTION PROGRAM UPDATES !

We've received several questions about violation procedures, including how the process works and which forms to use. To address this, both **YPP-007** and **YPP-008** have been updated and are now available under the **Youth Protection** section on the JDI website.

YPP-007 now includes a new category of **Financial Impropriety**. The reporting form for abuse cases, **YPP-008**, has also been revised to provide clearer guidance on the reporting process and outline what steps need to be taken when a potential abuse case arises.

In addition, we've created a document that outlines the process for filing a violation report and what happens once it is filed. As a reminder, all violation reports—per the instructions on the form—are submitted directly to the Supreme Office.

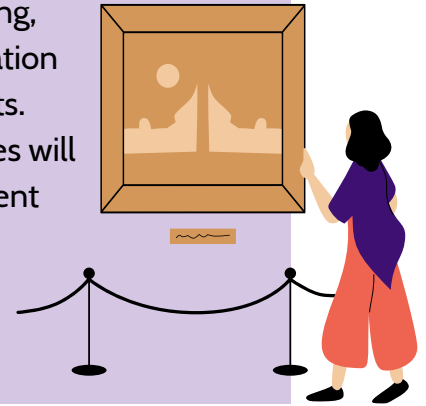

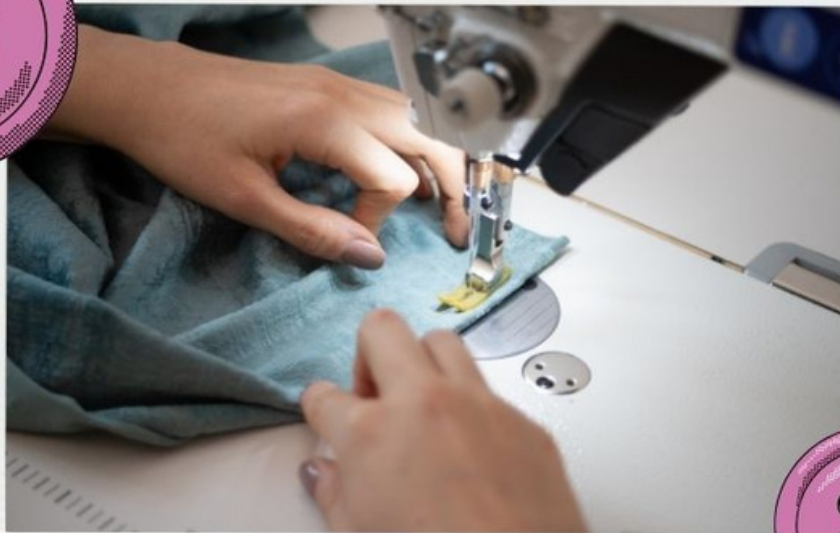

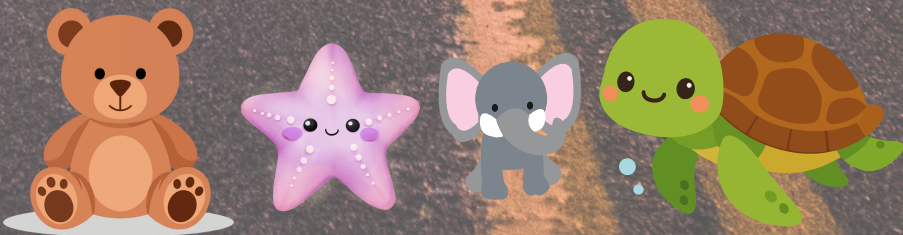
