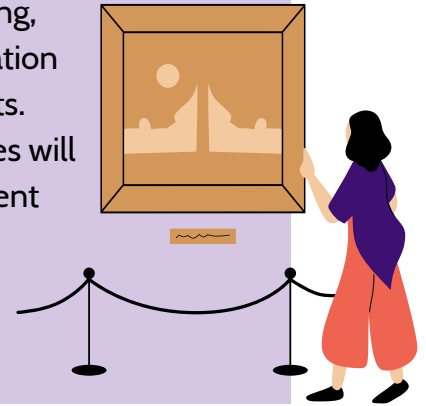

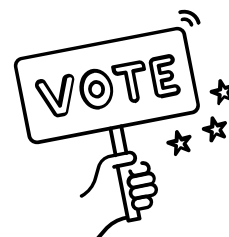
DAUGHTER VOTING DELEGATES

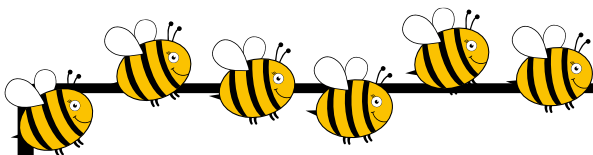
JDI PRIDE AWARD
